Academic Performance in KSD

What You Should Know

In recent months parents have wondered about the quality of education that their children are receiving in KSD schools. This prompted a look into the data. **The chart below is a snapshot of student experiences.** Kirkwood School District has many strengths and is recognized as a strong school district, but **this data merits more attention in open discussions where the future of our children is concerned.** Why is this deterioration in KSD's academics happening?

MAP scores are admittedly not the full picture of a child's academic experience, but they are very telling, and **these declines and the percentages below proficient are significant and unacceptable**. Yes, COVID-19 and virtual schooling were factors over the past two years, but it would be an oversimplification to presume that those are the only factors.
